



2024 Winter Competition

Competition Structure:

To promote fair play and provide all teams with an equal opportunity to compete, the following changes have been implemented to the competition structure:

Player Eligibility:

- Teams can have a maximum of 9 points or 4 rep players. (points apply regardless of age)
 - Rep Players in 1st team = 3 points
 - Rep Player in 2nd team = 2 points
 - Rep Player in 3rd/4th or DP = 1 point
- Representative players are only allowed to play in Division 1 competitions.
- Each team may have a maximum of 8 players on their roster.
- Players must be registered members of their respective teams.

Friday competition U10, U12, U14, U16, U18 Boys Division 1 U13 U15 Girls Division 1
Sunday Competition U14 U16 U18 Boys Division 2

Uniform Regulations:

- Uniforms must be the same colour with numbers front and back. Players must wear team shorts or black shorts with no zippers. 5 points per player out of uniform will be awarded to the opposition at the discretion of the court Supervisor.
- Under garments must be compression wear and black. Headwear must be black.

Game Duration and Structure:

Games will be two twenty minute halves 2 minute half time. 1 time out per team per half the clock will stop.

The clock will stop in the last two minutes if the score is within 10 points.

Under 12's and Under 14's are NOT permitted to play Zone. One warning will be issued followed by a Technical foul should the team continue to play zone

3 points will be awarded for a win, 2 for a draw, 1 for a loss, -3 points for a forfeit along with a \$100 fine payable prior to the next round match.

Standard FIBA game rules will apply to all matches.

Scoring and Fouls:

Scoring will be done on courtside with visible play by play and live scoring. Bonus will occur after the 7th team foul.

Officials and Their Duties:

Team Managers are responsible for ensuring the team are aware of game times and that there is a parent available for bench duty for each match.

Code of Conduct and Sportsmanship:

BNSW Zero Tolerance and Sports Rage rules apply.

Players who receive a Technical foul will be required to return to the bench for 5 minutes, if a player receives two technical fouls they will be placed on a behavioural agreement.
