

2024 Winter Competition

Competition Structure:

To promote fair play and provide all teams with an equal opportunity to compete, the following changes have been implemented to the competition structure:

Player Eligibility:

Any junior teams playing in or entering the Wolves junior competition is permitted a maximum of nine (9) points per team or four (4) representative players per team.

All representative players are to be classified with a point's value.

- 3 Points Any player selected/placed in Team 1 for the Wolves
- 2 Points Any player selected/placed in Team 2 for the WOLVES
- 1 Point Any player selected/placed in Team 3 4 or a DP for the WOLVES
- 2 Points Any player selected/placed in Team 1 for the WOLVES, playing in an older age group.
- 1 Point Any player selected/placed in Team 2or below or a development player for the WOLVES, playing in an older age group.
- 3 points Any players selected/placed in a representative team for an Association other than The Wolves
- Any player who attends the WOLVES representative trials but is cut from the program and not selected and is then selected at another Association will carry the following representative points value when playing in their correct age group.
- 3 Points All Premier and Division 1 representative players
- 2 Points All Division 2/3/4 or DP
- 2 Points All Divisions representative players playing up an age group.
- All players selected/placed in the WOLVES representative program must play in their correct age group. Players will only be permitted to play in a high age group if approved by the association.
- Any player selected for the WOLVES must play in the highest division or grade available when playing in their correct age group and cannot play lower than Division 2 when playing in an older age group.
- Any U10 player selected/placed to any representative team must play in the U12 competition and will be classified with a 2-points rep value.
- Any request for an exemption for any of these items must be in writing to Sports Operations Manager for consideration.

Uniform Regulations:

- Uniforms must be the same colour with numbers front and back. Players must wear team shorts or black shorts with no zippers. 5 points per player out of uniform will be awarded to the opposition at the discretion of the court Supervisor.
- Under garments must be compression wear and black. Headwear must be black.

Game Duration and structure:

Games will be 2×20 minute halves 2 minute half time. 1 time out per team per half the clock will stop.

The clock will stop in the last two minutes if the score is within 10 points.

Under 12's and Under 14's are NOT permitted to play Zone. One warning will be issued followed by a Technical foul should the team continue to play zone

3 points will be awarded for a win, 2 for a draw, 1 for a loss, -3 points for a forfeit along with a \$100 fine payable prior to the next round match.

Standard FIBA game rules will apply to all matches.

Scoring and Fouls:

Scoring will be done on courtside with visible play by play and live scoring. Bonus will occur after the 7th team foul.

Officials and Their Duties:

Team Managers are responsible for ensuring the team are aware of game times and that there is a parent available for bench duty for each match.

Code of Conduct and Sportsmanship:

BNSW Zero Tolerance and Sports Rage rules apply.

Players who receive a Technical foul will be required to return to the bench for 5 minutes, if a player receives two technical fouls they will be placed on a behavioural agreement.
